Membership / Data:

- 83 Membership
- Data is actually getting busy with all of the fundraisers and the marching band essentials coming in

- LISA: "Do we have a list for ordering for essentials yet?" yes.

Merchandise, Brynn Lange

- I have stocked up for Merch Sales through the fall, Parent preview night and home show events
- Full set up of all merch at the parent preview night
- Tried to order classics but also some new inventory for the people who have everything
- There will be an on-line sale in September with the items arriving in time for Christmas

Raise Right, Lauren Chychota:

- 167 families signed up for Raise Right
 - 106 families have online payments enabled
 - 10 families purchased \$4960 in gift cards
 - Net rebate to SFMA was \$242.84 for average rebate of 4.9%
 - The student share of the rebates was 145.71
 - The SFMA share of \$97.13 was reduced by \$11 for shipping (only one order was placed in June) for a net return of \$86.13

- In the 7 years that SFMA has been using RaiseRight there has been 1.25 Million Gift Cards sold, \$55,000 in rebates and \$20,000 earned for SFMA
- · Giant is offering E-gift cards now so that's exciting, just don't do self checkout when you use them
- Air BnB is on there. So you can enjoy a vacation and earn SPA points!
- Fewer physical gift cards are being ordered so I may change it from twice a month ordering to once a month to save money on the shipping fees.

Ram Crew, Tom Kuch:

- We are in a good spot for the props. New people have been coming out to help which is great
- Everyone please continue encouraging people to sign up for Ram Crew on the Sign Up Genius'
- Towers are out there right now being used for practice. They will eventually light up.

Sponsorships, Erika Nelson:

- · Getting lots of new sponsors. It has been really exciting
- Limerick Diner: \$150, Penny's Pizza: \$500, RailRoad Bar and Grill: \$1000, Dry Tech: \$500, Community Music School: \$200, Christina from State Farm: check not in yet
